CONDITIONS OF PLAY

CONTROL.

The Coolum Beach Sports Club Games Committee shall be the Controlling Body for this event and shall adjudicate should any disputes arise, and to make, alter or add to these conditions should that be deemed necessary and their decision shall be final and no appeals considered.

LAWS OF THE GAME.

All players competing in this event acknowledge that this event shall be conducted in accordance with the Laws of the Sport of Bowls, Chrystal Mark 4th Edition dated April 2023 and the Conditions of Play for the event.

ELIGIBILITY.

A player must be a Male member of an affiliated club.

GAMES.

The competition shall be conducted over two days, Saturday 27th and to Sunday 28th June 2026 and comprise a series of 6 games of 16 ends duration, or 2 hours 10 minutes.

SCORE CARDS.

Scorecards shall be completed by the second player in each team. They shall check the score at the end of each game and upon agreement, sign the cards. The winning Second shall immediately take both cards to the Bowls Office to be recorded.

ATTIRE.

Players shall be attired in accordance with the current Bowls Australia Dress Guidelines. Any approved sponsors attire shall be approved by the controlling body.

PLAY CONDITIONS.

Trial Ends. NO trial ends.

Dead Ends. The jack will be re-spotted on the T mark in the centre of the rink. A dead end occurring after time has elapsed shall not be replayed.

DETERMINING THE WINNERS.

The winning Team shall be the Team with the highest number of WINS plus the HIGHEST AGGREGATE MARGIN. Where there is more than one Team equal, the team with the HIGHEST NUMBER OF WINNING ENDS will win. No Team can win more than one prize.

DELAYING PLAY.

Players shall play their bowls without delay. Players changing ends as part of playing an end shall do so without delay. No Player is to deliberately delay play. If a complaint is received, the Umpire or Controlling Body shall warn the player and Team Skip on the first occasion. If the same offence occurs a second time, the End will be regarded as completed and the End awarded against the offending Team with a score of 4 points.

POSITION AND MOVEMENT OF PLAYERS.

Players not engaged as part of the head shall retire to at least 2 metres behind the Head.

Unless invited to do so by the Skip, the Leads, Seconds and Third Players shall only proceed to the Head after both Thirds have delivered both of their bowls. The Skips may inspect the Head after the delivery of each of their bowls but shall not unduly delay play.

ELECTRONIC DEVICES.

The use of all electronic devices is prohibited within 4 metres of the field of play unless specific approval is received from the Umpire or Controlling Body. If any breach of this condition is observed by the Umpire or

Controlling Body, they shall warn the player and Team Skip on the first occasion. If the same offence occurs a second time, the End will be regarded as completed and the End awarded against the offending Team with a score of 4 points.

SMOKING OR VAPING.

Smoking or vaping is only permitted within the designated DOSA areas of the Club or outside of the Club grounds.

SUBSTITUTE OR REPLACEMENT PLAYERS.

Laws 32 and 33 of the Laws of the Sport of Bowls, Chrystal Mark 4th Edition dated April 2023 shall apply. The Controlling Body shall adjudicate should any disputes arise and their decision shall be final and no appeals considered.
